Dissemination and implementation – expected outcomes

- preparation and publication of 3 scientific articles
- participation in 2 scientific conferences at the international level
- organization of a seminar summarizing the project
- it is expected that each NGO employee will use the learned methods with at least two persons/clients (16 people in total), and each academic teacher will conduct at least one workshop with a student group, using the approach learned in the project (a group of 10 people x 4 teachers = 40 people)

- 1st day for external guests, 2nd day for project participants,
- <u>During the 1st day</u>: key note speaker/ Lieve and Roland presenting the DPA/empowerment, presentation of research results, the website and tool box presentation, participants experience expression + the workshops for external guests prepared by the project participants
- <u>During the 2nd day</u>: closing the process for project participants + project Copil

Evaluation excerpts from the project application

- Each of the training sessions will be evaluated. Participants will complete questionnaires summarizing the training, including among others questions about the adequacy of the training methods used and the way the trainer works. The results of the inquiry will be the basis for a possible modification of subsequent training.
- The developed tools for working with excluded people will be tested by NGOs employees as part of Action Research. Each training session will be preceded by a presentation of the conclusions of NGO employees - such action will allow for adjusting the tools to the real needs of people involved in the work, as well as direct recipients of social assistance.
